



A.L.P.S. Study Hall Guidelines

The Monroe County School Corporation – School Age Care Program operates the A.L.P.S. Study Hall Program at UES. The A.L.P.S. Study Hall is intended to be a quiet study environment in which students can work on homework, required reading and prepare for tests. In order to serve the needs of the students and derive the most benefit from the program the following guidelines have been established:

#1. Students will be expected to maintain a voice level “0”.

#2. All students are required to work independently. Any group work must be non-disruptive and will be limited to two students. Group work must be pre-approved by the study hall coordinator. Students must maintain a voice level “1”.

#3. Students must come to study hall with all the necessary materials. Students will not be allowed to return to their classrooms.

#4. Students will only be able to leave the study hall room to perform volunteer work in the school building with expressed or written prior notice by a teacher/school administrator to the study hall coordinator.

#5. All students are required to stay until the end of study hall. Parents are not allowed to pick students up early from the study hall room.
